Dear Adrienne Thompson:

This is in response to our recent e-mail correspondence dated January 30-31, 2017. We originally contacted you because of a question about the publication of this work and the deposit material you submitted for registration.

You indicated on your application that this work was published in 1983. The law is very clear that any work published prior to March 1, 1989 must bear an appropriate Copyright Notice. If a work was published without the appropriate copyright notice, the copyright was lost. Therefore, before we can register any work published prior to March 1, 1989 we must see a copy of the work as it was originally published in order to ascertain whether or not the original work contained the appropriate notice.

As of this writing you have not yet addressed the issue concerning the deposit copy. In addition, you have indicated that you submitted a GATT registration for this same work. If a work is eligible for a GATT registration it cannot be registered on a regular form. Therefore, we must refuse registration for two reasons:

1. We do not have the appropriate deposit copy
2. We assume that the work is not eligible to be registered on a regular form because you have submitted a Form GATT for the same work.

In accordance with our practices, we will keep the application, copy, and non-refundable fee.
